

RESOLUTION NO. 2005 - 064

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR TO INCLUDE THOSE OBLIGATIONS SET FORTH WITHIN THE PARK MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE SOUTHWEST MEADOWS SANCTUARY – MODIFICATION #1 (CALUSA CORNERS), –OS-115, ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT “B” TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN AND BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE TOWN’S FIVE (5) YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2005, the Town Council approved Resolution 2005-___ authorizing the Town to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County, Florida, for the acquisition, preservation, improvement, enhancement, operation and management of the Southwest Meadows Sanctuary – Modification #1 (Calusa Corners); and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement, the Town is obligated to furnish Broward County with a performance bond, letter of credit, or resolution indicating that the obligation set forth within the Park Management Plan will be included within the Town’s five (5) year Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to satisfy its obligation under the Interlocal Agreement by including within its five (5) year Capital Improvement Program the obligations contained within the Park Management Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:


Section 1. The above referenced recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby affirms the obligations set forth within the Park Management Plan for the Southwest Meadows Sanctuary and hereby authorizes the Town Administrator to include the Management Plan’s obligations within the Town’s five (5) year Capital Improvement Program.

Section 3. That this Resolution will become effective immediately upon its adoption.




