CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

2025 CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDELINES: SOUTHWEST RANCHES

Dear Southwest Ranches Residents:

WM, in partnership with the Town of Southwest Ranches, is pleased to be your environmental solutions provider. Delivering exceptional service is our goal. Please review our **2025 collection guidelines** to ensure you get the most from your curbside collection service. Thank you for your cooperation and being a valued WM customer!

CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- All trash must be placed **INSIDE** your green WM cart. **Please bag your trash.** Loose, bagged garbage outside of a green cart, or in another container, **WILL NOT** be collected.
- Place your green cart curbside by **7 am** on your scheduled collection day.
- **Cart** must be **THREE (3) FEET** from parked cars, mailboxes, trees, utility poles or fencing and other potential hazards with cart handles facing your home.
- **Recycling** items should be loose, **NOT BAGGED.**
- Help prevent truck fires and **DO NOT** place items such as batteries, oil, pool chemicals, propane tanks or hot coals in your cart.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes paint, batteries, tires and similar materials. **Electronic Materials** include computers, computer monitors, televisions, printers, scanners, and similar devices. Neither HHW nor Electronic Materials are collected as solid waste, recycling, or bulk trash.

2025 Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days will be held at the Rolling Oaks Barn, 17630 SW 56th Street, from 8 am to 2 pm.

BULK WASTE GUIDELINES

Bulk trash includes, but is not limited to, large appliances (refrigerator doors must be removed with Freon free sticker visible), white goods, couches, chairs, mattresses, tables, carpets and padding, and vegetation debris. Bulk trash must be placed separate from regular garbage and must be generated by the resident at the home where it is collected.

- Bulk trash must be placed curbside in a neat and orderly manner for safe collection by an overhead grapple truck.
- Loose items must be placed in a bag, box, carton, or crate that can be safely lifted without breaking and be no more than four (4) feet in length and weigh **NO MORE than 50 pounds.**
- Glass items must be in a rigid taped container.
- Bulk waste **cannot be placed out earlier than the weekend before your scheduled collection day and no later than 7 am on collection day.**
- Residents are permitted a **maximum of 12 cubic yards** of bulk waste to place out for collection.
- No contractor generated material will be collected.
- No household hazardous waste (paint, motor oils, pesticides, pool chemicals and batteries) will be collected curbside.
- No horse manure will be collected.
- **Bulk piles that EXCEED 12 cubic yards** will be tagged and **not collected unless** you call WM at (954) 974-7500 to schedule a pick up at an additional cost.



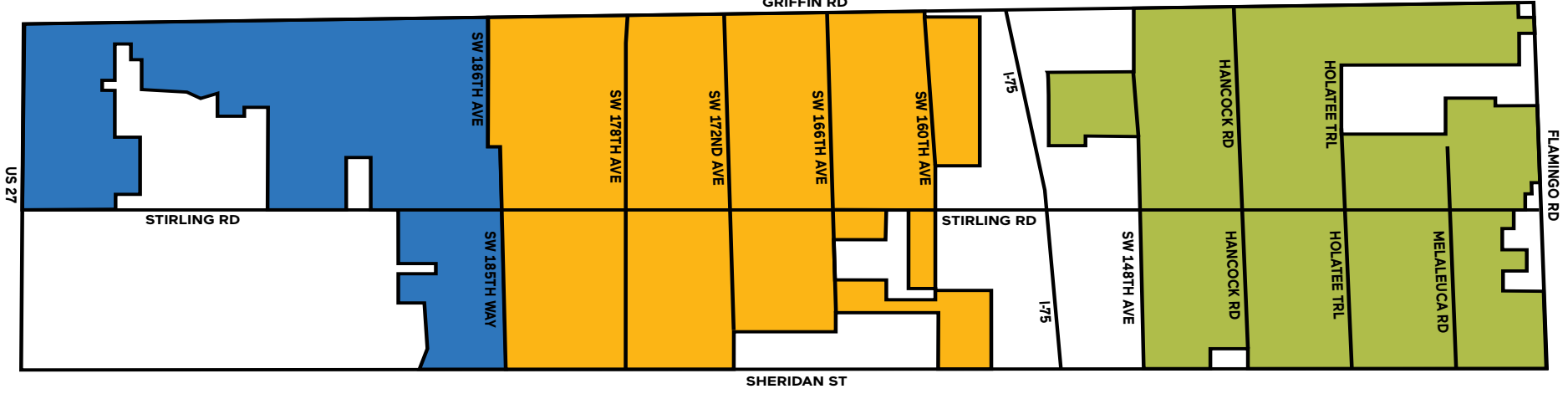
Or you can reduce the material to 12 cubic yards or less, and call WM to reschedule service within three (3) business days at no charge.

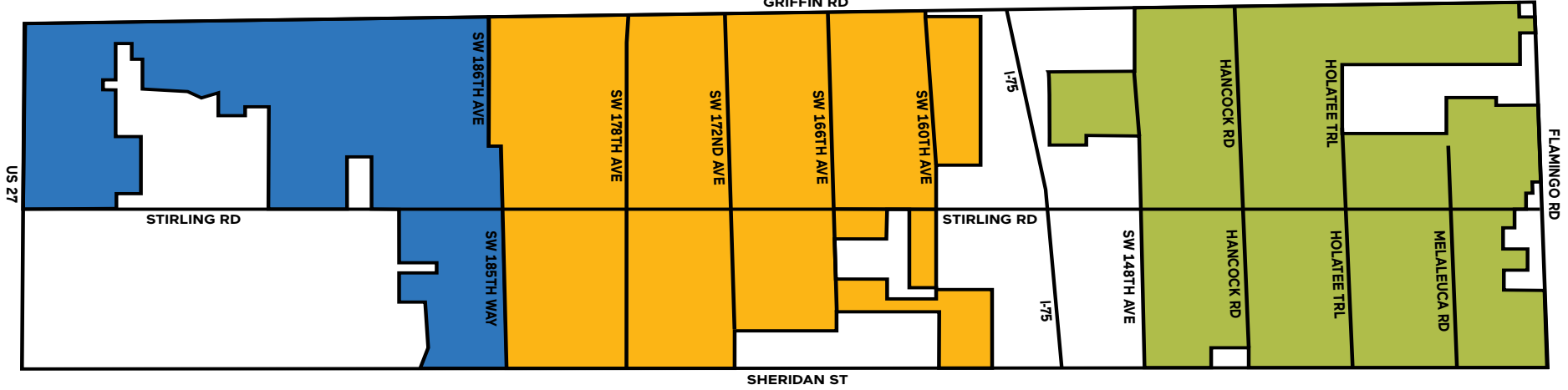


2025 SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE: SOUTHWEST RANCHES

GARBAGE ■ MONDAY & THURSDAY ■ TUESDAY & FRIDAY ■ WEDNESDAY & SATURDAY



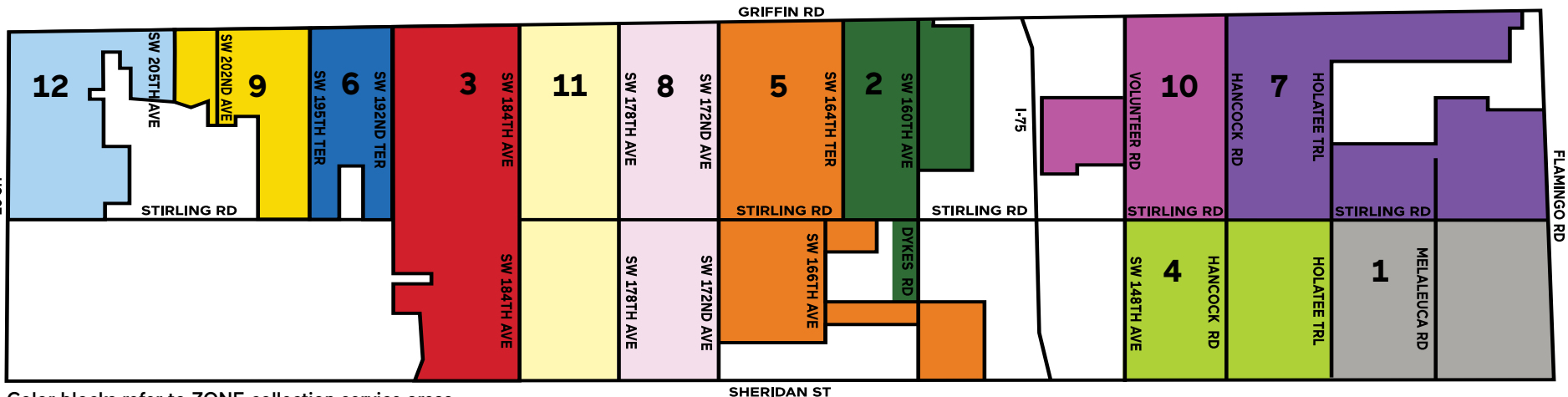

WM will provide trash service on every holiday with the exception of **Christmas Day**. If your trash collection day falls on Christmas Day, your trash will be collected on your next scheduled collection day.
