### **Discussion Items:**

- Financial Report by treasurer reflected a balance of \$37,616.38 + \$500 that was approved by Country Estates HOA to be brought to Town Hall.
- We will finalize the scholarship amount at the June 14<sup>th</sup> meeting. Only a couple applications received, and expect about 12 or so applicants by the deadline. The scholarships will be distributed at the Town Meeting on June 24<sup>th</sup>. Discussed sending invitations to those that contributed to the Flamingo Flocking to attend the Town Meeting when the scholarships will be distributed and may be some kind of slide show to present during the meeting.
- Town Hall will open to the public in June.

- Shared information from the SWR Parks Board to make residents aware that the Monarch Butterflies population has declined tremendously in recent years. Through the National Wildlife Federation's Mayor's Monarch Pledge, U.S. cities, municipalities, and other communities are committing to create habitat for the monarch butterfly and pollinators, and to educate residents about how they can make a difference at home and in their community. Monarch butterflies like the milkweed plant.
